

Psalm 27 • Wait for the Lord

1. (v.1-3) True **hope** and **trust** in the Lord produces a **confident** faith in spite of the **agenda** or **actions** of our adversaries.
2. (v.4-6) In reality, biblical “**escape**” is allowing God to effect our **deliverance** and **victory**. Our main focus throughout is to continually engage in authentic **worship** of and **service** to God alone.
3. (v.7-10) We are not the **author** nor **instrument** of our salvation. When we realize it is the Lord alone who saves (both **literally** and **spiritually**) then we **wait on Him** for all outcomes.
4. (v.11-14) The correct response to all **opposition** both spiritual and literal is to “**wait on the Lord**”; in the meantime, we should engage in a spiritual **reassessment** of our self.
