<p><sup>10</sup>Now when Jesus heard this, He marveled and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel. <sup>11</sup>I say to you that many will come from east and west, and recline at the table with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven; <u><b>12but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></u>" (Mt. 8:10-12)</p>	<p><sup>25</sup>"Once the head of the house gets up and shuts the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock on the door, saying, 'Lord, open up to us!' then He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know where you are from.' <sup>26</sup>Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets'; <sup>27</sup>and He will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you are from; depart from Me, all you evildoers.' <sup>28</sup><u><b>In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth</b></u> when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, <u><b>but yourselves being thrown out.</b></u> <sup>29</sup>And they will come from east and west and from north and south, and will recline at the table in the kingdom of God. <sup>30</sup>And behold, some are last who will be first and some are first who will be last." (Lk. 13:25-30)</p>	<p><sup>40</sup>"So just as the tares are gathered up and burned with fire, so shall it be at the end of the age. <sup>41</sup>The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and <u><b>they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness, and will throw them into the furnace of fire;</b></u> <sup>42</sup><u><b>and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></u> <sup>43</sup>Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear. (Mt. 13:40-43)</p>	<p><sup>47</sup>"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet cast into the sea, and gathering fish of every kind; <sup>48</sup>and when it was filled, they drew it up on the beach; and they sat down and gathered the good fish into containers, but the bad they threw away. <sup>49</sup>So it will be at the end of the age; <u><b>the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous,</b></u> <sup>50</sup><u><b>and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></u> (Mt. 13:47-50)</p>	<p><sup>11</sup>"But when the king came in to look over the dinner guests, he saw a man there who was not dressed in wedding clothes, <sup>12</sup>and he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without wedding clothes?' And the man was speechless. <sup>13</sup>Then the king said to the servants, <u><b>'Bind him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'</b></u> <sup>14</sup>For many are called, but few are chosen." (Mt. 22:11-14)</p>	<p><sup>45</sup>"Who then is the faithful and sensible slave whom his master put in charge of his household to give them their food at the proper time? <sup>46</sup>Blessed is that slave whom his master finds so doing when he comes. <sup>47</sup>Truly I say to you that he will put him in charge of all his possessions. <sup>48</sup>But if that evil slave says in his heart, 'My master is not coming for a long time,' <sup>49</sup>and begins to beat his fellow slaves and eat and drink with drunkards; <sup>50</sup><u><b>the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour which he does not know,</b></u> <sup>51</sup><u><b>and will cut him in pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></u> (Mt. 24:45-51)</p>	<p><sup>26</sup>"But his master answered and said to him, 'You wicked, lazy slave, you knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I scattered no seed. <sup>27</sup>Then you ought to have put my money in the bank, and on my arrival I would have received my money back with interest. <sup>28</sup>Therefore take away the talent from him, and give it to the one who has the ten talents.' <sup>29</sup>For to everyone who has, more shall be given, and he will have an abundance; but from the one who does not have, even what he does have shall be taken away. <sup>30</sup><u><b>Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></u> (Mt. 25:26-30)</p>
