<i>Kill lamb & put blood on doorpost</i> Ex. 12:6-7	<i>Purging of all leaven</i> (symbol of sin)	<i>Wave offering of sheaf</i> (promise of harvest to come)
1st month, 14th day Lev. 23:5	1st month, 15th day for 7 days Lev. 23:6-8	Day after Sabbath Lev. 23:9-14

40 Days Called "The Omer"

Feast of Weeks or Pentecost <i>(Shavu'ot)</i>
<i>Wave offering of two loaves of leavened bread</i>
50 days after First Fruits Lev. 23:15-21

Interlude Between Festivals

Feast of Trumpets
<i>Trumpet blown – a holy convocation</i>
7th month, 1st day Lev. 23:23-25

10 Days called "The Days of Awe" or "Terrible Days"

Day of Atonement <i>(Yom Kippur)</i>	Feast of Booths <i>(Sukkot)</i>
<i>Atonement shall be made to cleanse you</i> Lev. 16:30	<i>Harvest celebration memorial of tabernacles in the wilderness</i>
7th month, 10th day Lev. 23:26-32	7th month, 15th day, for 7 days; on 8th day, Holy Convocation Lev. 23:33-34

Regathering of Israel in preparation for final day of atonement
(Jer. 23:37-41)

Israel repents & looks to Messiah in one day

Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin."

...For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. (1 Cor. 5:7b)

Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. (1 Cor. 5:7,8)

But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep. For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming. (1 Cor. 15:20-23)

But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.
(Jn. 16:7)
