Overview of Genesis 27-35 (The Origin of Israel)


- Gen 27—Jacob steals Esau's blessing

- Gen 29—Jacob meets Rachel; Laban's treachery
- Gen 30—All the sons of Jacob (except Benjamin)
- Gen 31—Jacob flees Laban; covenant at Mizpah
- Gen 32—Jacob wrestles with the angel of the Lord
- Gen 33—Jacob encounters Esau; settles in Shechem
- Gen 34—Simeon and Levi's slaughter at Shechem
- Gen 35—Jacob settles in Bethel; named changed to "Israel"
