“The Sermon on Righteousness” (Pt. 8)

Matthew 5:1-16

Theme: Is it not the righteous who are blessed? You are more blessed than you’ve been told. Here’s why.

Key verse: *“Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.”*

Matthew 5:17 – 7:12

Theme: You are blessed because your righteousness can surpass that of the Pharisees (the Law). Here’s how.

Key verse: *“In everything, therefore, treat people the same way you want them to treat you, for this is the Law and the Prophets.”*

Matthew 7:13-27

Theme: But hearing My words isn’t enough. The truly righteous are those who *act on them*. Here’s how.

Key verse: *“Everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock.”*
